

# Bramley Class Weekly Overview

## English

We will be creating a Role on the Wall for the character in our mystery book. We will also be thinking about how we describe others and how other describe us.

## Phonics

Year 1 will be starting a new unit in Phase 5. Year 2 have finished their Phase 5 review, therefore we will now focus on using their phonics within their handwriting and English sessions. We will continue with review spellings, which we are taking from Little Wandle 'Year 2, Phase 5 Review Spellings'.

## Handwriting

Year 2 will continue to work on their joins, letter orientation and ensuring we start to join all writing automatically. We will also link our handwriting with our spellings for the week. Year 1 will be working on their letter positions and keeping their writing on the line.

## Maths

### Year 1

We are continuing our unit 'Counting within 20'.

In this unit we will:

- Count within 20 and work on our understanding of 10-20
- 1 more and 1 less from a given number to 20
- Look at the number line to 20
- Use a number line to
- Estimate on a number line to 20
- Compare numbers to
- Order numbers to 20

### Year 2

We are continuing our unit 'Money'.

In this unit we will:

- Count money using pence
- Count money using pounds (notes and coins)
- Count money mixing pounds and pence
- Choose notes and coins for a given amount



- Make the same amount using different coins and notes
- Compare amounts of money
- Calculate with money
- Make a pound
- Find change
- Solve two-step money problems

### Science

For science this week we will be discussing how the weather changes throughout the seasons. We will look at different photographs taken in different seasons and talk about what we can use in those photos to help us identify the correct season.

### PE

This term, our P.E unit will be Fitness. We will focus on agility, balance, speed, stamina and coordination.

### Topic

This week for Topic we will be learning about the reasons for moon travel and also looking in more depth at Neil Armstrong. We will also be looking at sliding mechanisms for moving picture books.

### RE

This week we will be exploring why Moses was important in the giving of the Ten Commandments.
