One of our school values is 'Family' and by having a school uniform, it promotes a sense of belonging to our school family. It creates a shared identity, pride in our school and a sense of purpose, of everyone working together. Below, you will find our policy on school uniform and by accepting a place at Speen School you are agreeing to abide by this uniform code which has been agreed by the governing body.

The school colours are royal blue and grey. **All items of school clothing, including shoes and socks must be clearly marked with your child's name.** It is of prime importance that all children are able to dress themselves before they start school, including putting on and taking off shoes and socks/tights.

WINTER UNIFORM – from October half term, weather dependent

- White, long-sleeved shirt (Reception class can wear a polo shirt if they find buttons difficult)
- Grey shorts / trousers / skirt or pinafore dress
- Royal blue V-necked jumper or cardigan
- School tie (years 1 and 2)
- Grey or white short/long socks or grey tights
- Coats: Navy blue or plain, dark coloured coats / anoraks are preferred

SHOES

- Black school shoes (with non-marking soles)
- Black plimsolls
- Wellingtons for Forest School

SUMMER TERM UNIFORM

- Plain white, short-sleeved shirt & tie (Reception pupils can continue to wear a polo shirt)
- Grey shorts or Pale blue & white check dresses
- Short white socks
- A Summer hat or cap (preferably in a school colour) to wear outside in sunny weather

PE KITS

- Royal blue shorts
- Round necked white t-shirt
- Black plimsolls
- Round necked royal blue sweatshirt & tracksuit bottoms for colder weather

OTHER ITEMS

- A royal blue book bag
- A royal blue draw-string PE bag
- No responsibility is taken for watches which can only be worn if a child can tell the time
- No items of jewellery including earrings should be worn
- Long hair should be tied back and kept out of eyes for safety in practical activities
- Named hat and gloves for Forest School and general colder weather (younger children benefit from gloves being on a string through the coat's arms)

Generic items are widely available (including from low-cost outlets).
