English

This week we will be continuing with our book for this term: The Storm Whale. We will writing our assessment writing, a recount.

Phonics

Maths

Year 1

We will be starting our new unit, 'Place Value within 100'. In this unit we will:

- Count from 50 to 100
- Tens to 100
- Partition into tens and ones
- The number line to 100
- 1 more, 1 less
- Compare numbers with the same number of tens
- Compare any two numbers

Year 2

We be working on our new unit, statistics. In this unit we will:

- Make tally charts
- Make tables (numbers and tallies)



- Block diagrams
- Draw pictograms (1-1)
- Interpret pictograms (1-1)
- Draw pictograms (2, 5 and 10)
- Interpret pictograms (2, 5 and 10)

Science

Our unit for this term is Growing Plants. We will be planting seeds and monitoring them as they grow.

PE

This week we will start our country dancing, ready for the Speen Summer Fete.

Topic

Our Topic this term is Seas and Coastlines. This week we will be investigating the islands of the UK.
