## English

This term in English, we will start with a new 'Mystery Book' (the title of which will be revealed very soon!). Throughout reading the text, we will aim to accomplish lots of wonderful English tasks, such as instruction writing, map creating, diary writing, finishing with an assessment writing piece at the end of term.

## Handwriting



Year 2 will be revisiting curly caterpillar letters and the joining our high frequency words, as these are words we will be writing on such a regular basis. A lot of the Year 2's have already started to join, which is a fantastic start.

Year 1 will be learning about our different handwriting letter families and writing the patterns to support these.

## Maths

### Year 1

This week we will focus on counting and our number knowledge, as well as how to use our different mathematical equipment to help us.

In this first unit we will look at:

- Sorting objects
- Counting objects
- Representing objects
- Recognising numbers as words
- Counting on from any number
- 1 more / 1 less
- Less than/greater than/equal to
- Using a number line

### Key Vocabulary

One more, one less, tens, ones, after, before.

### Year 2

Our first maths unit for Year 2 is Place Value to 100. This week we will focus on recognising and counting numbers past 20 to 100.

In this unit we will:

- Use numbers to 20
- Count objects to 100 by making tens
- Recognise tens and ones
- Use a place value chart
- Partition numbers to 100
- Write numbers to 100 in words
- Count in 10s and 1s on a number line

### Key Vocabulary

Count in steps, count in multiples, place value, estimate, compare

## Science

Our science topic for this half term is 'Materials'. This week we will be learning about how to identify different materials and what

we can think of that is made from these materials, for example pencils made from wood, cutlery made from metal etc.

Topic

Our topic for this term is 'Toys and Puppets'. We will be looking at toys from different times and comparing them to the toys that we have now.

RE

Our RE topic for this term is 'Why do Christians call God Creator?'. This week we will think about the how Christians describe God in Genesis.

PE

We are starting the term with our 'Fundamentals' - establishing the rules and expectations in P.E and working on our basic physical skills.
