English

This week, we will continue to work on our term text, Patten's Pumpkin, working towards story writing at the end of term.



Phonics

Year 1 now have 10 spellings each week. Keep practicing these at home and don't worry if your child finds them hard - if this is the case, choose 5 to focus on and let us know. Year 2 will also continue with their spellings, working through the Little Wandle spellings scheme. Please remember that there is method to the madness with the spellings as they work with the rule that we will be

learning each week in phonics.

Maths

Year 1

We will be continuing our unit, 'Place Value to 50'.

In this unit we will:

- Count from 20 to 50
- Work on number recognition and use to 20, 30, 40 and 50
- Count by making groups of tens
- Make groups of tens and ones
- Partition into tens and ones
- Use the number line to 50
- Estimate on a number line to 50
- Find 1 more and 1 less to 50.

Year 2

We are continuing our unit, 'Mass, Volume and Capacity'.

In this unit we will:

- Compare mass
- Measure in grams
- Measure in kilograms
- Work on operations with mass
- Compare volume and capacity
- Measure in millilitres
- Measure in litres
- Work on operations with volume and capacity

Science

This week we will cover what animals eat and how this differs amongst different species.

PE

This term we will be focussing on gymnastics. Later in the Spring we will have our inter school football tournament, so lets get working on those ball skills when we can, too!

Topic

We will be continuing our topic of India and discussing the human features of India.

RE

We will continue learning about Judaism, focussing again on The 10 Commandments and rules within the Jewish Faith.
