## English

## Handwriting

Year 2 will continue to work on their joins, letter orientation and ensuring we start to join all writing automatically. Year 2 writing is getting much better and much neater, please try to encourage joining as much as possible at home. Year 1 will work on their letter sizing and how we write our capitals larger than lower case letters, along with orientation of numbers - please remember that we do not expect children to join in Year 1, however we do encourage them to have a try if they would like to.

## Maths

### Year 1

We will be continuing with our unit 'Place Value within 50'.

In this unit we will:

- Count from 20 to 50
- Work with numbers to 20, 30, 40 and 50
- Count by making groups of tens
- Work with groups of tens and ones
- Partition into tens and ones
- Use the number line to 50
- Estimate on a number line to 50
- Work out 1 more and 1 less to 50



## Year 2

We are continuing with 'Mass, Volume and Capacity'.

In this unit we will:

- Compare mass
- Measure in grams
- Measure in kilograms
- Work on operations with mass
- Compare volume and capacity
- Measure in millilitres
- Measure in litres
- Work on operations with volume and capacity

## Science

We will be continuing our unit, 'Animals Including Humans'. This week, we will be exploring how we care for living creatures and what different living things need to survive.

## PE

This term we will be focussing on Gynastisc. Later in the Spring we will have our inter school football tournament (Year 2 only), so lets get working on those ball skills when we can, too!

## Topic

We will be continuing our topic for this term - India. This links with our term book, 'Pattan's Pumpkin'.

## RE

We will continue learning about Judaism, focussing on rules and the Ten Commandments.
