Week Commencing 14th September 2026

English

We continuing with our Mystery Book; creating a Role on the Wall for the character that we have met in the book, along with using the illustrations to tell us what the story might be about.

Phonics (Year 1) - We will be reviewing all graphemes taught this year.

Phonics/spellings (Year 2) - working on the different digraphs for the 'ee' sound. Spellings to be tested on Monday 14th September:

Handwriting -

Year 2 will be revisiting curly caterpillar letters and the joining our high frequency words, as these are words we will be writing on such a regular basis.

Year 1 will be learning about our different handwriting letter families and writing the patterns to support these.



Maths

Year 1

This week we are continuing work on counting and our number knowledge, as well as how to use our different mathematical equipment to help us.

In this unit we will look at:

- Sorting objects
- Counting objects
- Representing objects
- Recognising numbers as words
- Counting on from any number
- 1 more / 1 less
- Less than/greater than/equal to

- Using a number line

Key Vocabulary

One more, one less, tens, ones, after, before.

Year 2

This week we will be looking at how we partition numbers using part-whole models, finding different combinations to make numbers.

In this unit we will:

- Use numbers to 20
- Count objects to 100 by making tens
- Recognise tens and ones
- Use a place value chart
- Partition numbers to 100
- Write numbers to 100 in words
- Count in 10s and 1s on a number line

Key Vocabulary

Count in steps, count in multiples, place value, estimate, compare

Science

In Science this week we will be looking at the names and uses for different parts of the body.
