## Maths

### Year 1

- We will be starting our new unit, Geometry - Position and Direction. In this unit we will:
- Describe turns
- Describe position - left and right

- Describe position - forwards and backwards
- Describe position - above and below
- Understand and use ordinal numbers

## Year 2

We will be starting our new unit, 'Statistics'. In this unit we will:

- Make tally charts
- Draw and read tables
- Draw and read block diagrams
- Draw pictograms (1-1)
- Interpret pictograms
- (1-1) Draw pictograms
- (2, 5 and 10)
- Interpret pictograms (2, 5 and 10)



## Science

Our unit for this term is Plants and this week we will be looking at what a plant needs in order to grow and thrive. Our trip to Kew will be a hug part of this!
