Week Commencing 22nd September 2025

English

We are continuing our text for this term, 'How to Find Gold', and this week we will be making our own sea monsters! Please send in lots of lovely recycling that we can use for junk modelling - boxes, tubes, tubs etc.

Phonics (Year 1) - We will be reviewing all graphemes taught this year.

Phonics/spellings (Year 2) - continue to work on the different digraphs for the 'ee' sound.

Handwriting -

Year 2 will be starting to work on our joins between letters from the different letter families, using patterns to help us.

Year 1 will be building on their letter orientation and formation, looking at the different letter families.

Maths

Year 1

This week we are continuing work on counting 1 more, 1 less and counting backwards.

In this unit we will look at:

- Sorting objects
- Counting objects
- Representing objects
- Recognising numbers as words
- Counting on from any number
- 1 more / 1 less
- Less than/greater than/equal to
- Using a number line

Key Vocabulary

One more, one less, tens, ones, after, before.

Year 2

This week we will be looking at how we order numbers and objects, comparing and estimating, and counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.



In this unit we will:

- Use numbers to 20
- Count objects to 100 by making tens
- Recognise tens and ones
- Use a place value chart
- Partition numbers to 100
- Write numbers to 100 in words
- Count in 10s and 1s on a number line

Key Vocabulary

Count in steps, count in multiples, place value, estimate, compare

Science

In Science this week we will be identifying materials and their properties and thinking about how an object's properties make it suitable for particular things.

Topic

This week we will be thinking about how the materials that toys are made from have changed, from toys that we have compared to older toys that we have looked at.

RE

This week, we will be thinking about The Creation as told in the Psalms.

PE

During our PE lesson this week, we will be continuing with our work on the Fundamentals of P.E, following different instructions and noticing the way our bodies change when we exercise. We will also be building on our team work skills.
