English


Maths

Year 1

We will be continuing with our unit 'Place Value within 50'.

In this unit we will:

- Count from 20 to 50
- Work with numbers to 20, 30, 40 and 50
- Count by making groups of tens
- Work with groups of tens and ones
- Partition into tens and ones
- Use the number line to 50
- Estimate on a number line to 50
- Work out 1 more and 1 less to 50



Year 2

We will be starting our new unit, 'Fractions'. In this unit we will:

- Introduce parts and whole
- Learn about equal and unequal parts
- Recognise a half
- Find a half
- Recognise a quarter
- Find a quarter
- Recognise a third
- Find a third

Science

We will consolidating all of our learning from this term on our topic 'Animals Including Humans'.

PE

This term we will be focussing on gymnastics. Later in the Spring we will have our inter school football tournament, so lets get working on those ball skills! We have a football tournament coming up after Easter, so we'll be trying to get some extra football practice in too.
