Bramley Class Weekly Overview


Week Commencing 15th September 2025

<u>English</u>

We are continuing our text for this term, 'How to Find Gold' by Viviane Schwarz. This week we will be responding to the artwork in the book and creating our own sea monsters.

Year 1

This week we are continuing work on counting and our number knowledge, as well as how to use our different mathematical equipment to help us.

In this unit we will look at:

- Recognising numbers as words
- Counting on from any number
- I more / I less
- Less than/greater than/equal to
- Using a number line

Key Vocabulary

One more, one less, tens, ones, after, before.

Year 2

This week we will be looking at how we partition numbers using part-whole models, finding different combinations to make numbers.

In this unit we will:

- Use numbers to 20
- Count objects to 100 by making tens
- Recognise tens and ones
- Use a place value chart
- Partition numbers to 100
- Write numbers to 100 in words
- Count in 10s and 1s on a number line

Key Vocabulary

Count in steps, count in multiples, place value, estimate, compare

Science

We are continuing with our topic, 'Materials'. This week we will be describing the properties of a range of materials.

Topic

We will be thinking about toys from our Grandparents and Parents, looking at the differences to our toys that we have today.
