

Bramley Class Weekly Overview

Week Commencing 19th January 2026

English

We will be working on our own 'Sound Collector' poems, then moving on to what we think of as 'Treasures', working with the poem 'Treasures' by Clare Bevan.

Phonics

Year 1 will continue their work on Phase 5 phonics and spellings. Year 2 will also continue with their spellings, working through some harder words and using homophones (words that sound the same but look different - pair and pear, for example).

Handwriting

Year 2 will continue to work on their joins, letter orientation and ensuring we start to join all writing automatically. We will also focus on capital letters and their sizing comparison to lower case letters. Year 1 will work on their letter sizing and how we write our capitals larger than lower case letters.

Maths

Year 1

We are continuing our unit 'Counting within 20'.

In this unit we will:

- Count within 20 and work on our understanding of 10-20
- 1 more and 1 less from a given number to 20
- Look at the number line to 20
- Use a number line to
- Estimate on a number line to 20
- Compare numbers to
- Order numbers to 20

Year 2

We are continuing our unit, unit, 'Multiplication and Division'.

In this unit we will:

- Begin to recognise, make and add equal groups
- Introduce the multiplication symbol
- Work with multiplication sentences and arrays
- Make equal groups - grouping
- Make equal groups - sharing

- Work with the 2 times-table to then multiply and divide by 2
- Build on our doubling and halving
- Work with odd and even numbers
- The 10 times-table to then multiply and divide by 10
- The 5 times-table to multiply and divide by 5

Science

For science this week we will be thinking about the basic survival needs of animals and humans. What do we need to have to survive? Is that humans need different to what other animals need? Does that differ for different groups of animals?

PE

This term, our P.E unit will be Gymnastics. We will focus on agility, balance, speed, stamina and coordination.

Topic

This week for Topic we will be talking about the greatest achievements of Mary Seacole.

RE

This week we will learn about why the Shema very important for Jewish people.
