

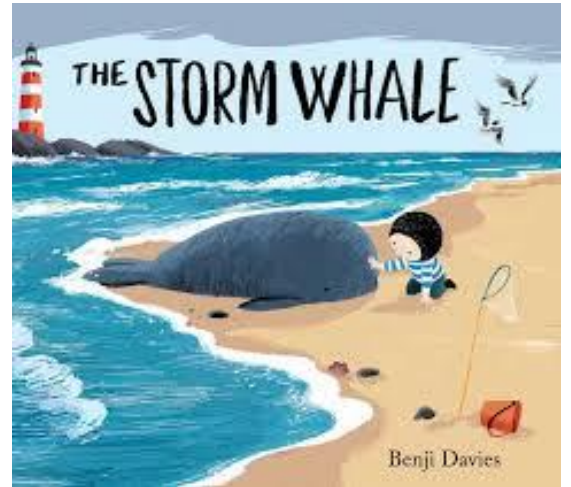
Bramley Class Weekly Overview

English

This week we will be continuing with our book for this term: The Storm Whale. We will be exploring 'recounts' and drafting our own recount.



Phonics

We're straight back in with our phonics and spellings. Year 1 will be working on reading nonsense words as well as real words, which helps to build on their confidence with blending and decoding. The following website has some great games to play at home to help with this:

Year 2 will continue with the Little Wandle scheme, building on how we use our knowledge of phonics and spellings to help us in our everyday writing and particularly focussing on punctuation.

Handwriting

We have seen a wonderful improvement in handwriting over the last term, so this message for this term is simple - keep up the good work! We will keep going over lots of joins and practise, practise, practise.

Maths

Year 1

We will be starting our new unit, 'Place Value within 100'. In this unit we will:

- Count from 50 to 100
- Tens to 100
- Partition into tens and ones
- The number line to 100
- 1 more, 1 less
- Compare numbers with the same number of tens
- Compare any two numbers

Year 2

We will be continuing with our unit, 'Time'. In this unit we will:

- Identify o'clock and half past
- Identify quarter past and quarter to
- Tell the time past the hour
- Tell the time to the hour
- Tell the time to 5 minutes
- Minutes in an hour
- Hours in a day

Science

Our unit for this term is Growing Plants. We will be planting seeds and monitoring them as they grow.

PE

This week we will start our country dancing, ready for the Speen Summer Fete.

Topic

Our Topic this term is Seas and Coastlines. This week we will be investigating the islands of the UK.

RE

Our Topic for this term Judaism and learning about 'Shabbat'.
