Year 1

- Subtract ones using number bonds
- Subtraction - counting back Subtraction
- Finding the difference
- Related facts
- Missing number problems

Year 2

We will be starting our new unit, 'Time'. In this unit we will be learning to recognise and work with:

- O'clock and half past
- Quarter past and quarter to
- Tell the time past the hour
- Tell the time to the hour
- Tell the time to 5 minutes
- Minutes in an hour
- Hours in a day

Science

Our unit for this term is Food Chains and this week we will look at how different animals and living things depend on each other in a food chain.
