For English this week, we will be continuing with our book for this term, 'Winters Sleep', and exploring how different language can affect what we




are reading. We will then be learning how to enhance our writing with interesting language, such as exciting adjectives in poetry.

## Year 2

- Subtract two 2-digit numbers (across and not across a 10)
- · Compare number sentences and work on missing number problems
