





Topic: Autumn





Sticky Knowledge			
1	A year is split into 4 seasons		
2	The names of the 4 seasons are Autumn Winter Spring and Summer		
3	The seasons form a cycle and what this means		
4	Each season brings different seasonal changes		
5	Autumn is the name of the season that starts in September and ends in November		
6	Autumn is a season where the weather gets cooler and it gets dark earlier. (The days are shorter)		
7	Autumn is where we see changes in the trees around us- the leaves of some trees change colour and fall off. (As the leaves decay the green disappears(to be replaced by other colours.)		
8	During Autumn time some animals collect food ready for winter (squirrels) and some hibernate (hedgehogs) to escape the cold, they breathe more slowly and their body		







temperature gets lower.


