Information on pupils' progress	A termly report would be useful.	We understand that parents would like more face-to-face time with their child's teacher, which is why we offer four face to face meeting with parents each year. This is in addition to the written report received by parents at the end of the summer term. We will also be offering termly sessions for parents to come into the classroom and look at the work children have been doing or stay and play for Little Apples children.
