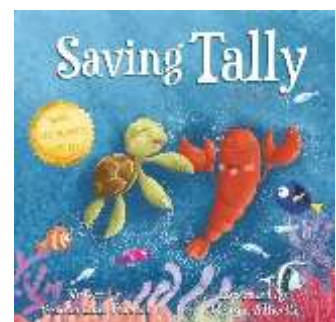
From the Children

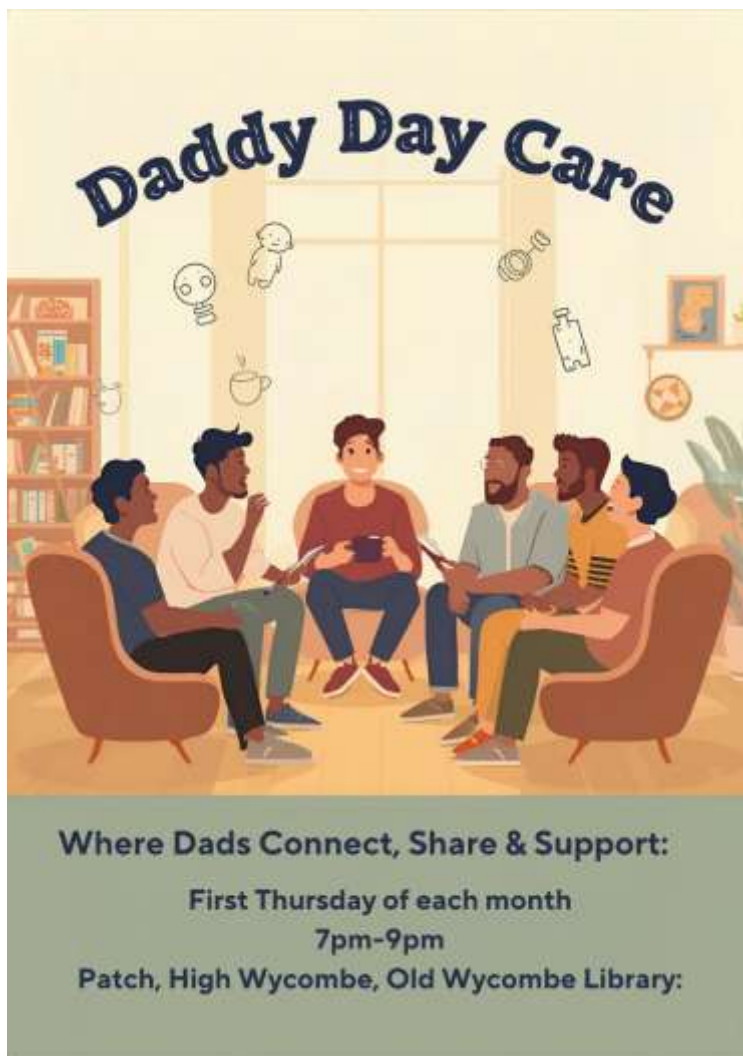
Dads Support Group
